## The 2012 Cup Regatta

in November, is the 5<sup>th</sup> annual 4 day  
Carnivale of Classic Yacht racing on Port Phillip Bay.

The Regatta celebrates the Trans Tasman and InterColonial Yachting Regattas sailed off Williamstown from the 1880's to the 1930's. Yachts sailed from New Zealand, New South Wales, South Australia and Tasmania to compete in these Regattas.

Many Classic Yachts racing in this Regatta are on the Australian Maritime Museum 's Register of Historic Vessels

Sayonara, Acrospire III, Windward II, Alwyn, Storm Bay and Oenone, Classic Yachts from the 1890's and 1920's will be racing against the Australian Classic ocean racing yachts from the 1960's and 70's, such as Mercedes III", arguably the most well known and most successful ocean racing yacht ever in Australia, "Boambillee" in 1969 a member Australia's successful Southern Cross Ocean racing team and "Kingurra" a 16 times Sydney to Hobart racer

Combined with a resurgent fleet of 10 Tumlarens that competed in the 1930's & 40's Bay racing, will be Queenscliff Couta Boats ,Port Phillip Bay Net boats and Corio Bay Net boats.

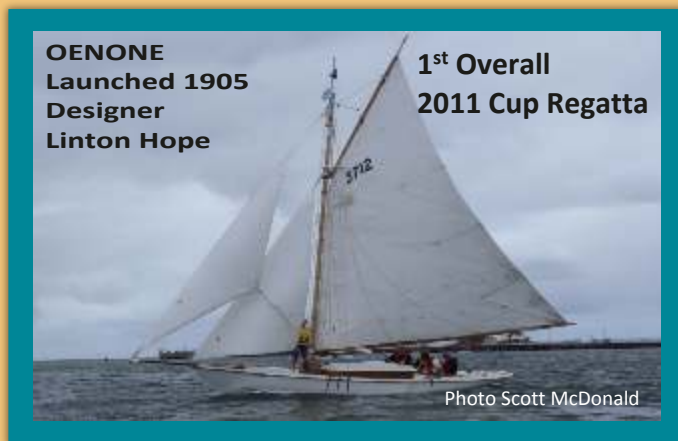
