SAILING INSTRUCTIONS for race SIX... On...28<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2010

**TWO CONSECUTIVE SHORT LAID COURSES**

The race will be conducted by ...ROYAL YACHT CLUB of VICTORIA.....

The race will be governed by the conditions as outlined in the NOTICE OF RACE and the rules as defined in the RACING RULES OF SAILING

The race will not start if the wind speed is 25 knots or greater, or if a GALE WARNING is current.

Handicaps are performance based and as per attached list

The scoring system is the “LOW POINT SYSTEM “ with modifications in accordance with the Notice of Race

At least three boats must rank as Starters or there shall be no race

**SCHEDULE OF RACE**

The scheduled time of the first warning signal on Sunday is 1025 hrs.

Upon completion of the first race the warning signal for the second race will be sounded/displayed as soon as practicable.

**THE COURSES**

The Courses to be sailed will be chosen from the following two alternatives.

At the warning signal the course to be sailed will be signalled by the display of the corresponding numeral pennant,.

Round all marks to Port:-

<b>Course 1</b>	<b>First Leg</b>	Starting line to Windward mark
	<b>Second leg</b>	Windward mark to Leeward mark
	<b>Third leg</b>	Leeward mark to Windward mark
	<b>Fourth leg</b>	Windward mark to Leeward mark
	<b>Fifth leg</b>	Leeward mark to Windward mark
	<b>Sixth leg</b>	Windward mark to Finish

<b>Course 2</b>	<b>First Leg</b>	Starting line to Windward mark
	<b>Second leg</b>	Windward mark to Wing mark
	<b>Third leg</b>	Wing mark to Leeward mark
	<b>Fourth leg</b>	Leeward mark to Windward mark
	<b>Fifth leg</b>	Windward mark to Leeward mark
	<b>Sixth leg</b>	Leeward mark to Windward mark
	<b>Seventh</b>	Windward mark to Finish

The approximate magnetic bearing of the first rounding mark in relation to the start mark will be displayed on a board on the Committee Vessel prior to the start.

The race committee will configure the course to achieve a finish time for the leading boat of approximately **40** minutes.

## **MARKS**

Marks of the course will be Orange Inflatable Marks

The Start Mark will be a Yellow Inflatable Mark

The Finish Mark will be a Yellow Inflatable Mark

## **THE START-[HOBSONS BAY]**

The Starting Line will be an imaginary line between the Signal Mast of the Committee Vessel displaying an orange flag and the Starting Mark ( a yellow mark).

## **FINISHING LINE**

The finishing line will be between the signal mast displaying an orange flag on the race committee boat and the finishing mark (a yellow mark).

## **TIME LIMITS**

The time limit for the first boat to finish the course shall be 70 minutes. The race will be valid for those boats that finish within 40 minutes of the finishing time of the first boat. All other boats crossing the finish line after this time will be scored DNF.

## **SHIPPING**

[1]Skippers shall at all times abide by the PoMC Regulations covering the navigation of small craft and yachts .They shall also abide by the directions of race officials patrolling shipping channels.

[11]Any Skipper subject of a complaint by a Ship's Master for any reason whatsoever may be disqualified.
