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Marseille Old Port Classic Wooden Boat Regatta

(places for up to 10 crew)

Marseille is the capital of Provence, second city in France and the main European port based on the Mediterranean.

Each year, between 30-40 wooden boats compete in the Classic Wooden Boat Regatta which runs from the Old Port in Marseille around the islands and along the coast in the beautiful Mediterranean waters – for 4 single days competition (no offshore). All yachts competing in this Regatta must have been built before 1949 in order to qualify. They are a sight to be seen, and being a crew member is like being on a movie set!

In 2012, we have chartered Nan of Fife – built in 1896 and almost 70 feet long – and owner, Philippe would love to have some Australian crew.

- Cost for each of the crew includes: boat hire, insurance, entry fees for the Regatta (A\$1600).
- Racing is from Thursday to Sunday (4 days)
- Practice day is on Wednesday 13th June when we will sail down the coast for a picnic and swim (weather permitting). Partners and/or guests may join us for this day at A\$75 p.p.
- Accommodation near old Port – 6 nights - Tue 12th June - Mon 19th June 2012 (A\$1050 single/A\$1200 shared - inc. breakfast)
