1 RULES

The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions and safety regulations of the AYF, and the Port of Melbourne regulations-all as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

2 ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY.

The series is open to CLASSIC

YACHTS, with the following conditions:

2.1 registered with the CYAA

2.2 owners/skippers are paid up members of the CYAA

2.3 member of a yacht club affiliated with YACHTING AUSTRALIA

2.4 has a current certificate of safety

Category 6 for Classics

Category 7 for Coutu boats

2.5 has completed, signed and submitted the attached “intention to race” entry form, along with entry fee, to the CYAA.

2.6 has appropriate insurance as detailed clause 12 below.

Classic yachts in this series are defined as yachts designed before 1970 and constructed of traditional materials

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- The sailing instructions and allocated/adjusted handicaps for eligible yachts for each race will be

available at least 24 hours prior to each race :

- on CYAA Website,

- emailed to all Skippers
- on organising club's website

5 VENUE

Northern end of PORT PHILLIP and HOBSON'S BAY

6 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be determined by the organising club, and will be taken from their respective current "Sailing Instructions" booklet.

7 PROTESTS

7.1 the protest committee will be comprised of the RACE director from the organising club and two committee members of the CYAA Victorian Division

8 SCORING

a The "LOW POINT SYSTEM " will be used

(a) If SIX or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) If SEVEN or EIGHT races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) Appendix A part A9 will be applied

(d) The series must comprise at least four races for there to be a result

- b.** Competing yachts will also be scored for the annual "Presidents Trophy"

9 HANDICAPPING

Handicaps will be adjusted on a past performance basis by the CYAA designated handicapper

Boats that sail infrequently or are new to the fleet may be given a "provisional" -P handicap.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be presented at the CYAA-VICTORIAN DIVISION PRESENTATION NIGHT.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material

damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000
